- ➤ She emerged as Winner in both U-13 Girls Singles and U-13 Mixed Doubles at the SPIKER Junior Open State Badminton Tournament, highlighting her all-round mastery on the court.
- ➤ At the Mini Sub-Junior Badminton Tournament, she clinched Winner in U-13 Girls Singles and secured 3rd place in U-15 Girls Singles, proving her competitive edge even in higher age groups.
- Continuing her dominant form at the SBM Tamil Nadu State Sub-Junior Badminton Tournament, Anjana was crowned Winner in U-13 Girls Singles and Runner-up in U-15 Girls Singles.
- At the SPN School of Badminton's 3rd Year Sub-Junior Tournament, she finished as Runner-up in U-13 Girls Singles and claimed 3rd place in U-15 Girls Singles.
- She added to her accolades with a silver medal in U-12 Girls Singles at the CBE Sahodaya Inter-School Badminton Tournament.
- Anjana displayed continued excellence by winning both the U-13 and U-15 Girls Singles titles at the Sub-Junior Open State Badminton Tournament.
- At the Transforms Open State Tournament, she finished as Runner-up in U-13 Girls Singles.

Continuing our Annual Sports Highlights, we proudly present Krithiv N.H. of Grade VI, who has carved a niche for himself in the world of roller skating and martial arts, achieving spectacular success at inter-school, state, national, and international levels. His journey is a shining example of speed, skill, and sheer determination.

- ➤ On the national stage, he earned a silver medal in the Road 7-lap event and gold in the Relay at the SSFI 23rd National Championship held at Swastika Rink, Coimbatore.
- Representing the school at the SSFI 24th National Championship in Madurai, he once again dominated the track, securing gold medals in Rink IV, Rink V, and Rink VI.
- At the CBSE Zonal Skating Meet (South Zone I), he bagged a silver medal in the 300m TT and gold in Rink IV.
- ➤ His winning streak continued at the CBSE National Skating Championship 2024 held at Shivaganga Sports Club, Belagavi, where he clinched gold in both the Road 7-lap and Rink IV events, earning yet another Individual Championship Trophy.
- Ending the season in grand style, at the 14th TNSSA State Meet 2024, Krithiv dominated the competition with gold medals in Rink IV, Rink V, and Rink VI, and was once again honoured with the Individual Championship Trophy.
- In the TNSSA Speed Skating Challenge 2024, he showcased remarkable speed and stamina, winning gold medals in the 5-lap, 2½-lap, and Rink Elimination events.
- At the State-Level Roller Skating Championship 2024, he once again stood at the top of the podium, claiming gold in Rink III and Rink IV, along with another Individual Championship Trophy.
- ➤ He commenced his competitive season by winning two bronze medals in Rink III and Rink VI at the Coimbatore Sahodaya Inter-School Skating Championship.
